EUROPEAN ROLLER



Only 25 pairs of these rare and protected birds are found in Latvia. Five families of Rollers breed in Adazi MTA each year.

Do not approach nest boxes of Rollers in spring and summer.

Adult birds are afraid to come near the nest box and chicks may die of hunger.

HOOPOE

Nest boxes for specially protected Hoopoe are placed in Adazi MTA.

Try not to approach Hoopoe nest boxes in spring and summer.

PROTECTED PLANTS

Military Orchid, Eastern Pasque Flower and other rare and specially protected plants delight with splendid flowers in Adazi MTA.

Leave them in nature, do not pick.

EUROPEAN NIGHTJAR

This protected night bird hunts its food – different moths – above the roads.

Drive carefully in the evening and at night to timely detect the Nightjar. Do not hit it.



DRY TREES

European Roller and other birds often perch on standing dry trees whilst watching for the food. Lying dry wood is a home for rare Jewel Beetles.



Dry wood is an important part of the landscape – leave it in the nature
